How to install and use the App

Available on cars up to 8 years old and 160,000 kms

The DIYinspect App can be found in the Apple App store or the Google Play store.

The App is used to get a wholesale price on your used vehicle.



The App looks like the image below.



### STEPS to Install the App and Login


1. Click "**Get**" in the Apple App store or "**Install**" in the Google Play store
2. Click "**Register**" button
  - create a company account? Yes / No
  - insert your name, email address and mobile phone number
  - read the terms and conditions and tick the box
  - click "**Create Account**" button
3. On the User Activation Page enter
  - activation code that was text to you
  - password and confirm password
  - click the "**Continue**" button

## Process for using the App


After logging into the App it will step you through a process as follows:

1. Enter your Registration number and choose your State



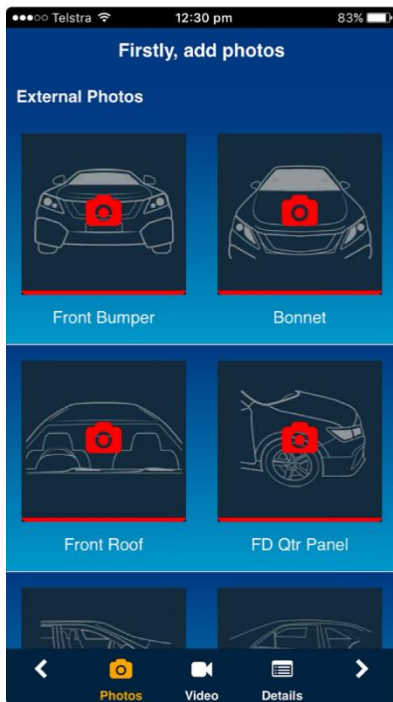

2. The App will then pre-populate your vehicle details such as the example below. If the details are incorrect you can reset the form and choose the correct details.



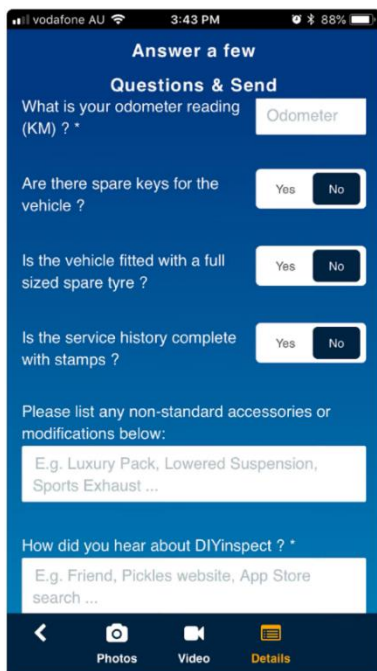
